Report on Ragging Case



In due course of time, these two students were suspended for a month from 16th December 2017 to 16th January 2018. Their mobile phones were also confiscated.

This case was handled first by Principal forwarded to Internal Complaints Cell Convenor Dr. Pratima Goyal who handled the case. Dr. Sunil Patil, Director of Student Welfare Means at University of Mumbai was also invited to discuss the case.

Dr. Patil visited college on 16th January 2018, met the students and their parents. Warning was given that they are being watched and this kind of behavior should not be repeated.
