- B.Sc. With Home Science (general or any specialization)
 - B.Sc. with, Microbiology / Biochemistry / Life Sciences / Biotechnology—6 units or Combinations
 - B.Sc. with Chemistry along with Microbiology/ Biochemistry/Life Sciences— Combinations
 - PG Diploma in Dietetics and Applied Nutrition/ Clinical Nutrition, B.Sc. Human Science
 - Minimum 50% at T.Y.B.Sc. examination.
 - Learners of any gender are eligible to apply for admission to the course.
 - As the course is interdisciplinary course admission criteria will be based on qualifying entrance examination as per circular No/DCC/2014-15/13/11-k pg2of4


